APPLICATION OF BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD FOR CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZING IT TO ABANDON A PORTION OF ITS CENTRAL MASSACHUSETTS BRANCH IN WORCESTER COUNTY, MASSACHUSETTS.

Respectfully represents the applicant, Boston and Maine Railroad, as follows:

- a. Its full corporate name is BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD.
- b. It is a common carrier by railroad subject to the Interstate Commerce Act.
 - c. It herewith seeks authority
 - 1. To abandon that portion of its so-called Central Massachusetts Branch which extends for about 25 miles from its so-called Oakdale station in the town of West Boylston to its so-called Wheelwright station in the town of Hardwick, all in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts;
 - 2. To abandon its operations under trackage rights over that portion of the lines of the moston & Albany Railroad (New York Central Railroad, lessee) which extends for about 6 miles from a point west of so-called Barre station in the town of Barre to so-called Creamery Road in the town of Hardwick, all in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

- d. Abandonment of the line first mentioned is sought; with respect to the other line abandonment of operation under trackage rights is sought.
- e. Service by the applicant on these lines is no longer necessary. Applicant has operated no passenger service on either line for more than six years. Freight service will be continued by the Boston & Albany Railroad on the line where applicant seeks to abandon its operations under trackage rights; the other line has recently been damaged by a flood and the traffic offered does not warrant its restoration or continuation of freight service there.

- g. Applicant is organized under the laws of Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts and New York, and is authorized to do business in Vermont.
- h. The making and filing of this application were authorized by a vote of the Executive Committee of its Board of Directors passed November 1, 1938, a certified copy of which is attached hereto.
- i. Attached here to is a copy of a situation map showing the lines in question and nearby rail lines. As indicated thereon, the lines shown are operated as parts of the systems of the Boston and Maine Railroad, Boston & Albany Railroad

(New York Central Railroad, lessee), or Central Vermont Railway.



- 1. To abandon that portion of this corporation's line which extends for about 25 miles from its so-called Oakdale station in the town of West Boylston to its so-called Wheelwright station in the town of Hardwick, all in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts;
- 2. To abandon this corporation's operations under trackage rights over that portion of the lines of the Boston & Albany Railroad (New York Central Railroad, lessee) which extends for about 6 miles from a point west of so-called Barre station in the town of Barre to so-called Creamery Road in the town of Hardwick, all in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts;
